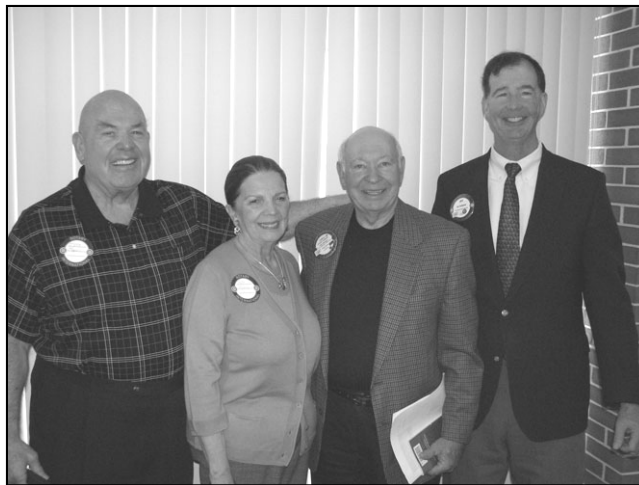
George "The Animal" Steele, or former professional wrestler Jim Myers, was the featured speaker for the Rotary Club of Cocoa on February 10, 2009. Jim was a football coach and a teacher from the 1960s to 1986. He won many awards and is in the Michigan Football Coaches' Hall of Fame and the World Wrestlers' Hall of Fame.

He graduated from Michigan State in 1961 and went to work, teaching and coaching, for \$4,300 a year. He needed additional jobs, so he was an umpire and a bouncer at a bar. A friend had Jim call a wrestling promoter, and the rest, as they say, is history.

Jim decided to wear a mask, and at one time, they called him the "student." He progressed rather quickly in the wrestling profession and eventually signed for \$8,500. He taught school and still coached while he was doing this on the side.

He would get out of coaching at 6:30, drive 150 miles to the ring, only to get home at 2 a.m. He did this for five years. On Saturdays, he travelled all day for TV shows. Jim eventually bonded with Bruno Sammartino (world champion). He was making \$5,000 a night and wanted to be a part-time wrestler. Other wrestlers were doing drugs and alcohol and dying in their 40's. Jim continued to teach until he retired in 1986. Nineteen years ago, he had chromes disease and was very sick. He and his wife, Pat, moved to Brevard County six years ago. Brevard County is privileged to have Jim as one of its residents.

Jim eventually bonded with Bruno Sammartino (world champion). He was making \$5,000 a night and wanted to be a part-time wrestler.
