This week's program

**Police Chief Mark Klayman
City of Cocoa**



On Tuesday, March 3, Rotarian Rev. Drew Wales was the featured speaker for the Cocoa Rotary. At his instigation, the Cocoa Rotary is involved in an international project that should help between 15 and 20,000 people. We will be helping the people in Mwanza (northwest corner of Tanzania) through our connection with Bishop Charles Sekelwa – who, by the way, is being inducted into a Rotary Club in that area.

The area church has 15 acres onto which they want to build a school and a clinic. Through a connection with Aid for the World we hope to obtain metal roofs to go onto the buildings. Bishop Sekelwa's dream is to one day build a middle school, a high school, college, and hospital in the area. Currently, they have one doctor to 40 – 50,000 people. There are thousands of AIDS orphans. Additionally, where there are 37.5 million people in Tanzania, over 50% of them are under the age of 15.

Tanzania lies just south of the equator in Africa with 120 tribes; its capital is Dodoma. The average income of people in the region is \$110 – 150 a year. Most are sustenance farmers – those who grow what they need to eat to live. Their government is a republic; the Head of State is Jakaya Mrisho Kikwete who is friendly. The future location of the school and clinic is 14 kilometers from Dodoma in Mwanza with a population of 300 – 500,000 people.

The clinic will improve the health of the children, provide awareness of how HIV/AIDS can be prevented, provide treatment and counseling for those with AIDS, and to treat and control malaria. The estimated cost of the clinic is \$24,000 + the 'sweat equity' Bp Sekelwa's people making the bricks and building the buildings. The school plans to start with 100 kids ages 5-10 and 10-15; the estimated cost of this is \$22,000. Currently, about \$6,000 more is needed to get our team to Mwanza. Contributions are needed as well as a matching grant with the district. For more information on how you can help, contact Father Drew 749-2956.
