School of Champions



The Cocoa Rotary was pleased to have Cocoa Police Force Chief Mark Klayman as its speaker for the day on March 10, 2009. He joined the Force in 1983 and became Chief in 2009. He shared with the Club his goals for the Force: reducing crime and building trust between the police and the community.

Chief Klayman listed for the Club some of the Outreach Strategies that had been undertaken by the Force: the Lemon Aid Stand, Crime Watch, High Visibility with Foot and Bike Patrols, School and Public Demos, School Resource Officer Program, Police Athletic League Committee Advisory Board, Community Alert, Special Events, VCOPS. Honor Guard, Drop a Dime, etc. Some of the Enforcement Activities include Zero Tolerance Crime targeted at street crime; Drug Enforcement; Burglary and Traffic units; Felony Criminal Investigation; Top 10 Offender Program; Project Safe Neighborhood (targeting gangs and guns); Loitering; Prostitution, and Alcohol Violations.

Chief Klayman mentioned that many officers wear different hat – meaning that they have a variety of assignments, some of which are as follows: Special Weapons and Tactics (SWAT) Team, Motor Unit Aggressive Driving Unit, DUI, Reckless Driving, Marine Unit (deals with environmental hazards and water rescue), and the K-9 Unit (which deals with narcotics detection and works with kids), Relay for Life with the American Cancer Society, Harry T. Moore preschool graduation, Holiday Events (Easter bunny at preschools), Bowling and Golfing with underprivileged kids in the summer, National Night Out, etc.

The Community Response Team (CRT) and Undercover Operations are working to get drugs and money off the streets. Currently, the Police Athletic League is being revitalized and Chief Klayman is optimistic about it. Overall, he said that there has been a reduction in crime, but the number of suicides, unfortunately, is increasing.
