Jim Underwood, President of MI Breakfast Club, announced that he and Ambassadorial Scholar Christina Dombresky, are working with all the 500 kindergarten children in Brevard County on a water safety program/ booklet. Drowning is the number one killer of kids 5 years and under - hence the program. Christina is "Josh" - the baby otter.

Christina is a graduate of the University of Florida with a MBA in International Business. She was the 2008-09 Ambassadorial Scholar who was sent to study for a year in Buenos Aires, Argentina. Buenos Aires has 33 Rotary Clubs; one-half of them are all male. She stated that it was a phenomenal experience to get to know Rotary through her over-seas adventure. During her stay, she was involved in a myriad of events, from the pinning of new members to getting to know the leadership of the clubs and attending and speaking at conferences. Christina even got to meet DK Lee, former RI President.

During her time there, she worked with the Rotaract Club on their projects, one of which was a field day for 250 kids and vocational orientation for high school students. While in Buenos Aires, Christina also joined Toastmasters, the only English speaking club in South America. She attended festivals of jazz, livestock and tango and went on a glacier trek. As a result of her visit, she says she now has the mindset of a traveler: a broader viewpoint on life. She did what she loves, and she loves what she did in South America. Now Christina is involved in RYLA and has started the first community based Rotaract Club in Del Ray Beach. What a wonderful example of what Rotary's Ambassadorial Scholarship Program can do!!
