Melissa Stains, President/CEO the Cocoa Beach Area Chamber of Commerce was the guest speaker for the Rotary Club of Cocoa on Tuesday, March 31, 2009. She noted that the Chamber was involved with "academies" at Merritt Island, Rockledge, and Cocoa Beach. At Merritt Island, there are environmental, law, and hospitality academies. At Rockledge, Sports, entertainment, and talent academies exist, and at Cocoa Beach, they have the business international academy. The Chamber hosts "Academy Awards" for the schools. The Cocoa Beach Area Chamber of Commerce is the largest chamber in the area, with 1,700 partners covering the Merritt Island, Cocoa Beach, Cape Canaveral, Cocoa, Viera, and Patrick Air Force areas. Melissa stated that the chamber is promoting "partners doing business with partners first." The <http://www.cocoabeach.com> website has had 24,000 visits and over 900,000 hits, and the Cocoa Beach Visitor Center on the beach has had over 1061 visitors (<http://www.cocoabeachchamber.com/>).
