**Chet Straub** with the **Technological Research and Development Authority (TRDA)** spoke to the Rotary Club of Cocoa on Tuesday, May 5, 2009. The TRDA Business Innovation Center assists start-up technology firms in Central Florida grow into commercially and financially viable high-growth companies. By bringing together a wide range of business resources under one roof, the Center creates a dynamic climate that encourages entrepreneurial success. Since its opening in May 2007, client companies have been creating high-value jobs, commercializing new technologies, attracting local and national capital investment, and strengthening the local economy.

The TRDA strives to improve the atmosphere where we work. It also strives for business incubation – taking an idea to something marketable and profitable. Education is another arena for the TRDA. It works with school districts from around the state and provides workshops and professional training for K-12 teachers to give them innovative technologies in a school setting. The Teacher Quest Program is an example of training for teachers, giving them the opportunity to work in a professional setting for up to seven weeks in the summer using technology. In addition, TRDA works with renewable energy companies who are trying to bring to market new alternative fuels. It works with small companies, bringing technologies to help them become more efficient, productive, and profitable. TRDA also assists with aerospace and defense funds, with access to government contracts, to promote projects. TRDA now has 13 technology-based companies or client firms which employ 71 people. Thirty four jobs have been created, and 42 applications for patents pending have been made and eight have been received.
