# This week's program



Last weeks program was presented by Agent Tom Mulligan with the Brevard County Sheriff's Office Sex Offender Registration and Tracking Unit.

Agent Mulligan let us know that there is 800 known registered sexual predators and/or offenders currently in Brevard County.

The Sexual Offender Registration & Tracking Unit (SORT) is responsible for the registration of all sexual predators and offenders in Brevard County. The Unit also provides community notification and address verification of offenders and predators and investigates violations of the registration and statutory requirements.

On September 1st, 2005, the Jessica Lundsford Act, significantly altered Florida's Sexual Offender and Predator Registration Laws. It resulted in tougher registration requirements and increased penalties for violations.

Sexual Offenders must report in person to the local Sheriff's Office or Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) office within 48 hours of release from custody and/or supervision of Department of Corrections or Department of Children and Family Services to register their temporary or permanent address.

The registration process takes about 30 minutes to complete and involves completing pertinent information relating to the crime committed, fingerprinting, and photographing. Registrants need to bring photo identification.

Sexual predators and offenders must report in person twice a year (during the month of his/her birth and in the 6th month thereafter) to the sheriff's office in the county in which he or she resides. Failure to comply with this requirement is a 3rd degree felony.
