Janice Shepard, with the Healthy Start Coalition of Brevard was the featured speaker for the Rotary Club of Cocoa on June 2, 2009. She stated that the Healthy Start Coalition of Brevard County is dedicated to establishing a system of care that guarantees all women have access to prenatal care and that all children have access to services that promote normal growth and development. The Healthy Start Coalition of Brevard County facilitates FREE risk factor screens for pregnant woman through obstetrician offices, the Department of Health (DOH) and other pregnancy centers. If a combination of risk factors are found, Healthy Start Coalition provides FREE services to reduce the factors and improve the birth outcome. Participation in the Healthy Start program is not income based - it is solely based on risk factors present.

Janice was very excited to promote Healthy Start's Space Coast Challenge fundraising event. This is an event that Brevard has NEVER seen before. Teams of two will race through the streets of Brevard (north, central and south) to raise awareness of Healthy Start, to raise money for the moms and babies of Brevard and to bring the community closer together by learning about themselves as well as the businesses that are right here in our own backyard. The teams will leave their cell phones, GPS's, work and life behind for three days and join the race through Brevard; finding clues, performing challenges, and having a great time!
