Founded in 1952, the Central Brevard Humane Society (CBHS) is Brevard County's oldest established animal welfare organization. A "no kill for space" shelter, CBHS is dedicated to speaking for those who cannot speak for themselves. The Humane Society educates the community on responsible pet ownership and the humane treatment of animals, advocates for spaying/neutering to reduce the homeless pet population and provides the best quality care to Brevard's abandoned animals by placing them with responsible, caring owners in "forever" homes.

The Central Brevard Humane Society provides an animal welfare shelter and programs that foster a humane ethic toward all animals. They also strive to deepen the community's commitment to spaying and neutering, as well as to the adoption of homeless companion animals. They believe this to be essential to achieving our purpose of humane care and treatment of all animals.
