This week's program

Josh the Baby Otter Club Water Safety Project



Last weeks program was presented by Barry Poppel with Pure Water for the World.

The roots of PWW began in 1994 when a dentist from the Brattleboro, Vermont Rotary Club volunteered to go to a small Salvadoran village to provide medical services. He was moved by the poor living conditions and vowed to make a difference and do something. With the support of his Rotary Club he decided to help the people by providing rural vil-lages with potable water. The success and interest of the club's activities soon outgrew the capacity of the Rotary Club.

As a result, Pure Water for the World, Inc. was set up as a 501(c) (3) organization to carry out this important humanitarian effort in 1999. With the fo-cused commitment of the Board of Directors, staff was hired to move the work forward.

Pure Water for the World (PWW) works in remote regions of developing countries which lack sustain-able clean, safe drinking water. We work with local governments and community partners to select, analyze the appropriate technology for the community, and to implement cost effective projects.

Our projects include a comprehensive education program to provide the community with the basic knowledge of water use, storage and personal hygiene and how all of these factors contribute to the health and well being of the users. To reinforce the health benefits of having clean, safe drinking water, we also provide parasitic treatment and the follow up and monitoring to make sure that the technologies are being used and that they are being used properly.

PWW has now installed individual sand filters to serve more than 700,000 people. We have 9 projects operating throughout Honduras; 2 in Haiti, 2 in El Salvador, and are in the process of initiating projects in the, Dominican Republic and Guatemala. We have 23 people working in country on our projects plus 6 technically trained volunteers, in addition to assistance from Peace Corp volunteers.
