Julie Irvin with Connected by 25 was our featured speaker for June 16th, 2009.

"They Just Need a Break". This is how a Brevard County CEO summed up the purpose of Connected by 25 Brevard. We are creating an effective system to help young people - ages 13-25 - transition from the foster care system into successful adulthood in our community.

Connected by 25 Brevard, initially funded by the Eckerd Family Foundation, brings together the vast resources of our county - public and private, for-profit and non-profit, groups and individuals - to help young people form a solid foundation of basic needs:

- safe, affordable, independent housing
- dependable transportation to schools, work, and leisure activities
- continuing education opportunities
- meaningful and challenging jobs
- practical life skills training in areas of finance, self-advocacy, and health care

Connected by 25 Brevard has two volunteer boards to develop and lead the effort: a community board and a youth board. These entities work in tandem to create innovative ways to reach their goals. The community board is comprised of members from all facets of Brevard County life. Representation includes volunteers from workforce development, finance, social services, leadership organizations, legal entities, health care, and civic groups. The community board also has representation of the young people we are serving. The youth board is a vibrant group that plans events, provides strategic and practical input, and works to promote individual responsibility and personal growth.

The strategies around Connected By 25 Brevard were developed and supported by national and local foundations that are members of the Youth Transition Funders Group and the Foster Care Work Group. They and their community partners are trying to improve the lives of the nation's most vulnerable young people.
