Wayne Ivey with the Florida Department of Law Enforcement was our featured speaker for June 30th, 2009. Wayne spoke to the members about Identity Theft and how to prevent it from happening.

Identity theft is one of the fastest growing crimes in America victimizing over 10 million people per year and costing billions of dollars. Identity theft can happen to anyone, anywhere, at anytime. It can happen in line at the store, online, or even at a restaurant. Technology and the availability of information is driving this crime wave at an alarming rate. If your identity is stolen you will spend hours trying to re-establish your credit and working to restore your good name. Listed below are ways you can help prevent identity theft.

1. Order and closely review copies of your credit report from each national credit reporting agency.
2. Reconcile your financial statements on a monthly basis.
3. Empty your wallet of extra credit cards and Id's.
4. Shred pre-approved credit applications, credit cards, receipts, and other financial information before discarding them in the trash.
5. Only release your personal information data to businesses that require it for action you have initiated.
6. Guard your passwords and PIN numbers closely.
7. Memorize your social security number and passwords. Do not record them on cards or anything in your wallet.
8. Deposit outgoing mail in mail collection boxes or at your local Post Office.
9. Contact your creditors or service provider if expected bills don't arrive.
10. Use caution when disclosing account numbers at any website or online service locations unless you receive a secured authentication key from your provider.
11. Don't email your personal data unless you use encryption technology.
