This week's program



Three members from the Congregations for Community Action (CCA) were the guest speakers for the Cocoa Rotary on Tuesday, November 4: Director Janice Everson, Linda Filippini, and Kathy Drane. Janice explained that the CCA is composed of is a faith-based community outreach organization whose mission is to empower ordinary people to make extraordinary changes which improve the quality of life in the community. CCA effects change in those institutions which touch our families, empowers those who are powerless, and awakens people to their greatest resource: each other.

Their vision is to see public officials, public agencies, and citizens working together toward a better place for families to live and prosper, a better Brevard County. Director Everson explained that ten churches comprise the CCA: Ascension Catholic, Holy Trinity Episcopal, Holy Name of Jesus Catholic, Mt. Moriah Missionary Baptist, Our Lady of Grace Catholic, Palmdale Presbyterian, St. Joseph Catholic, St. Paul's United Methodist, and Ward Chapel A.M. E.

Linda Filippini started as a volunteer seven years ago; now she is an administrative assistant/bookkeeper/fun developer. Kathy Drane began with CCA seven years ago with its first inception to Brevard County. She wanted to do more for the community and be a role model for her kids. Kathy stated that the reality in the community is often that the "Powers that be not knowing the reality of what is." Through CAA, she has realized that difference one small voice can make. Janice explained that most of the funding for the CAA comes from national sources, but they are looking for funding from local organizations as they are a grass roots 5013C organization.
