The Rotary Club of Cocoa experienced a busy lunch meeting on Tuesday, December 2! Several local agricultural and governmental leaders were in attendance to help celebrate the Club's 36th Annual Farm – City Celebration. Many thanks to Lowell Loadholtz and Frank Sullivan for organizing this special event each year and for the fruit that all of us receive to take home and enjoy.

In addition to this celebration, the Club welcomed Bruce Piatekot, Executive Museum Director of the Florida Agricultural Museum (FAM) in Palm Coast, Florida. Bruce began with the Museum in 1994 and has helped raise over one million dollars for the museum and over 10 million for the facilities. The goal of the FAM is to increase awareness of Florida Agriculture, with part of its mission to educate the public, preserve the past, and interpret the future. Part of former Commissioner Doyle Conner's goals was to save Florida's rural heritage and build a living museum to showcase Florida agriculture.

The master plan is to include five historic time periods in areas of the 400 acre reserve. One area will be a **Native American Village 1540's** and will feature foods, activities, and the daily life of those who lived then. Another area will be the **Colonial Spanish Ranch**, complete with Cracker cattle and horses introduced into North America. A **Plantations and Early Pioneer Setting 1850's** will feature such items as cotton, rice, sugar, indigo; slave life; foods, hunting, gathering, etc. **An Agricultural Town in the 1890's** area will focus on the production and movement of goods; saw mills; dairy products; orange groves, packing houses, churches, etc. Finally, a 5,000 square foot 1940's Farm and Caldwell dairy barn was also moved to the property.

The goal is for all of the above to be "interactive." Tours will be conducted from Thursdays to Saturdays, and there will be special events such as barn dances, horses and cattle visitations, and trail and wagon rides. Other special events and programs include haunted trails, a Walk Back in Time (third weekend in March), endurance ride, etc.

The FAM is a non-profit organization that exists mainly through private donations and support (such as the donation of buildings). It does have some governmental support. Membership is encouraged. 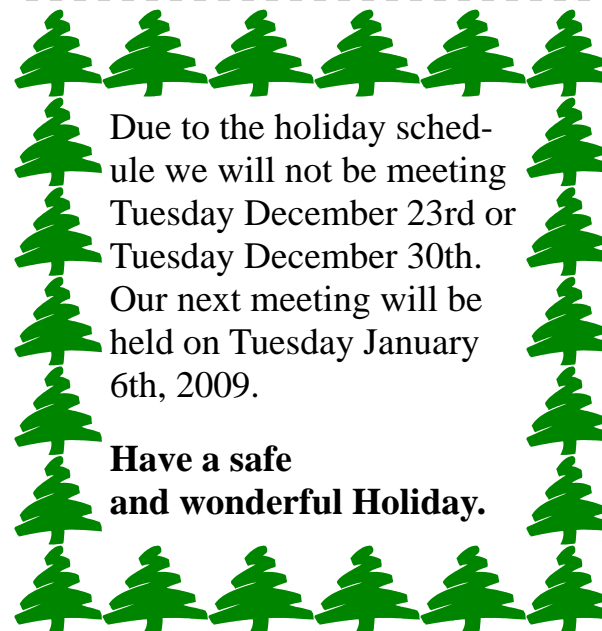
