BCC Youth Build Program



On Tuesday, August 5, Corporal Fred Abbey and his partner, Corporal Debra Brouillette of the Brevard County Sheriff's Office were the guest speakers for the Rotary Club of Cocoa. Fred is head trainer and has been with K-9 dogs for ten years and has eight years experience as M.P. canine trainer. Debra is assistant trainer for the Paws & Stripes program (P & S P).



The Paws & Stripes Program is a unique partnership between Brevard County Animal Service & Enforcement, the Central Brevard Humane Society, and the SPCA of North Brevard County. It is an innovative program which places dogs from local animal shelters into obedience training programs aimed at making them adoptable while also providing selected and trained inmates with valuable work experience.

The program began in 2006 when Sheriff Jack Parker wanted an education program at the jail. The P & S P started with three dogs and six inmates, was created by the community, and is now two years old. It is a non-profit organization; only the salaries of Fred and Debra are paid by the County. The Central Brevard Humane Society takes care of the donations – which includes money donated by Rotary Clubs. Inmates are paired with dogs for an eight-week training course. The dogs learn to heal, sit, recall, and stay. They are also house-trained and leash-trained. In addition, they are taught to be responsive to voice commands and hand signals. Inmates learn the skills of dog training, dog grooming, Red Cross Pet First Aid, and veterinary assistant skills. At the completion of each course, the inmates received documents of certification from the ABKA Pet Care Technician 1 course, and the dog is returned to the shelter for adoption.
