This week's program

Michelle Raymond, Program Director for BCC Youth Build, was the featured speaker on September 23 for the Rotary Club of Cocoa. The program is at the College based on a grant. The Space Coast Youth Build has been in Brevard County since 2004. Youth Build USA is a national program that was started in 1978.

The hours of the program are Tuesday – Friday or Monday – Thursday from 8:00-3:30 – 30 hours a week. Students who are in the program are in the GED program half of the time and at a Habitat work-site for half of their time (for which work they are paid). Students are referred to the YB program by drug court, probation officers, Devereaux, etc.

These students must be between 16-24 years of age who are NOT attending school and have no GED. Once students are enrolled in the program, they are drug tested and must attend a two-week orientation. Of the total, 70% are males. The goal is to move the student from obtaining his/her GED into the “work” field. What makes this program work are the two teachers per 15 students. In addition, there are two site supervisors, a case manager, and director. Currently, there are 21 students. A typical stay in the program is six to nine months. Their schooling consists of study in the areas of math, reading, science, history, writing, and language arts. To date, there have been 37 enrolled and 28 have completed the program. The Youth Build Program sounds as if it is making a difference in our community.
